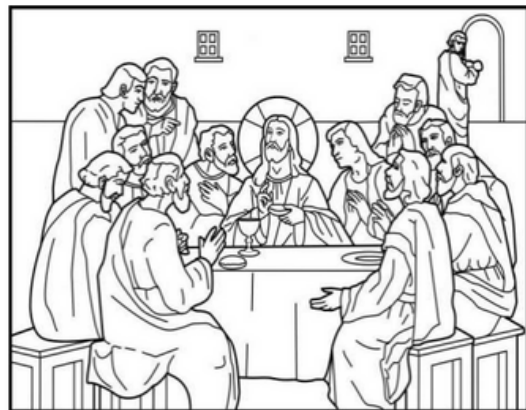
I say hello to Jesus!

Jesus gave us Himself under the form of bread and wine at the Last Supper, the first Mass!

This power to change bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus has been passed down to our priests today.

The host in the monstrance comes from the bread that the priest has changed into the Body of Jesus at Mass!

Look at Jesus in the form of a host in the beautiful monstrance!



Tell Jesus how much you love Him.

The word monstrance means "to show."

The monstrance "shows" us Jesus in the form of bread in a special way so that we can see Him easily with our eyes.

is so happy that you tell Him these things!

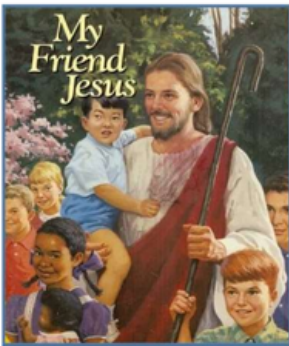
Now I listen to see if Jesus
