6	St. Michael the Archangel	Protector against Satan	Gladiator outfit with big wings and sword
7	St. Gabriel the Archangel	Messenger for God	White tunic with blue scarf, big wings, trumpet, lantern and lily
8	Biblical Patriarch Noah	Obedient servant of God; built the ark w/ his sons; patron of The Old Testament	Tunic with shawls
9	St. Philomena	Patron of: newlyweds, babies and youth	Blue tunic with red cape, crown of flowers, arrow, anchor, palm leaf or lily
10	St. Josephine Bakita	Patron of: Sudan, human trafficking survivors; former slave	Black dress with long sleeves and a black head wrap
11	St. Juan Diego	Tilma with image of the Virgin of Guadalupe; patron of indigenous people	White shirt, black pants, poncho & image of Our Lady of Guadalupe on tilma
12	St. Joan of Arc	Virgin heroine; patron of: France, soldiers, prisoners, youth	Armor and sword
13	St. Kateri Tekakwitha	Patron of: environmentalists, ecologists, Native Americans	Native American outfit
14	Fatima Children (Ven. Lucia, St. Francisco, St. Jacinta)	Witnessed the Blessed Virgin Mary and other visions at Fatima	Girls: peasant skirt and blouse with head scarf; boy: peasant pants and shirt
15	Bl. Louis & Bl. Zelie Martin	Parents of St. Therese of Lisieux & 4 more religious daughters	Suit (jacket and pants) and long dress

20	St. Faustina Kowalska	Had visions of Jesus, led to Divine Mercy painting, Message of Mercy; patron of gratitude in the family	Black nun habit
21	St. John the Baptist	Patron of: builders, tailors, baptisms, conversion to faith, many countries	Brown (hairy/shaggy) tunic, red shawl and a lamb
22	St. Monica	Patron of: married women, mothers, difficult children, victims of abuse/unfaithfulness	Either black or brown nun habit, a book and a cross
23	St. Nicholas of Myra	Patron of: children, merchants, travelers, unmarried people, students	Red cape with gold trim and accented with crosses, white or red tunic
24	Bl. Carlo Acutis	Patron of: youth and computer programmers	Red polo shirt , blue jeans and sport shoes
25	St. John Paul the Great (Pope JPII)	Patron of: Poland, Catholic families, World Youth Day, Catholic sports	Pope outfit
26	St. Benedict	Patron of: students, Europe	Black monk habit, book, bell, broken tray and crosier
27	St. Elizabeth Ann Seton	Patron of: Catholic schools, seafarers, widows, Catholic convents	Black cape, black long dress, ruffled black bonnet, a rosary and a book
28	St. Joseph	Patron of: Catholic Church, fathers, married people, sick and dying	Green tunic, brown scarf/cape, lilies
29	Bl. Solanus Casey	Capuchin priest who gave special masses for sick people; patron of: healers, spiritual counselors	Franciscan habit of brown tunic with large, pointed hood, woolen cord belt with three knots
